BOOKING FORM FREE THINK CO' WORKSHOP

Open to **charities**, **public bodies** and **private care agencies**, the training will introduce you to the signs and symptoms of CO poisoning, including the numerous health risks associated with frequent, low level exposure to this odourless, invisible and toxic gas. Knowing the signs and symptoms, and being able to manage the risks, will help organisations support vulnerable people and will ensure employers meet their Duty of Care to staff and volunteers.

The workshop is for people who have responsibility for training or supporting staff/volunteers who visit people in their own homes or for health and safety.

This event is fully funded by the Gas Safe Charity and is aimed at staff who provide training for front line service providers – either paid or volunteers. The focus is on raising awareness of the signs, symptoms and risks of Carbon Monoxide poisoning in the homes of vulnerable people and managing associated risks.

The venue is accessible and adapted. Usually only one place per organisation.
